A handcrafted gift made of a solid block of wood, the tradition of a male admirer crafting a lovespoon for a young woman indicated to the woman's family that he was skilled and capable with his hands. The oldest existing lovespoon in Wales dates back to 1667. Each specific carving on the spoon is symbolic, from the eternal love of the Celtic knot, to the twisted stem indicating togetherness

On 1 March each year we celebrate our patron Saint, Dewi Sant or St David who died on that day in 589AD

### The Harp

The harp is the only traditional instrument in Wales with an unbroken history up to the present day. It is also the instrument most often cited in Welsh literature through the ages

It took until 1959 for the Welsh national flag to be officially unfurled for the first time. The significance of the dragon in Welsh culture is believed to date back to Arthurian legend when Merlin had a vision of a red dragon (representing native Britons) fighting a white dragon (the

Saxon invaders). The use of green and white refer to the colours of the House of Tudor, the 15th century royal family of Welsh origin. The red dragon won the battle just in case you were wondering...

- There are 6 cities in Wales, 2 of which are in North Wales Bangor and St Asaph
- At 1085 metres high, Mount Snowdon is the highest mountain in Wales and it surpasses the heights of any mountain in neighbouring England and Ireland
- Snowdonia National Park is an International Dark Sky reserve, only the tenth place in the World to gain this status
- King Arthur Legend of the Sword (2017) was filmed in the area around Llyn Ogwen
- The historic South Stack Lighthouse is located on a small island reached via a descent of 400 steps down the steep mainland cliffs
- It was in Llandudno that CL Dodgson (also known as Lewis Carroll) created and set Alice in Wonderland
- The longest and fastest zip wire rides in Europe are in Bethesda North Wales
- 7 Wonders of Wales can be found in the North East Pistyll Rhaeadr and Wrexham steeple Snowdon's mountain without its people Overton yew trees, St Winefride's well Llangollen bridge and Gresford bell
- The longest running Punch and Judy show in the world is the one on Llandudno's promenade. Passed down through the generations, this show has been running for over 150 years
- Built in 1805 by Thomas Telford, the Pontcysyllte Aqueduct is the tallest aqueduct in the UK. It was once the tallest boat crossing in the world
