The club is ideally situated, just five minutes from the A55 expressway, 9 miles from Chester and 45 minutes from Liverpool and Manchester.

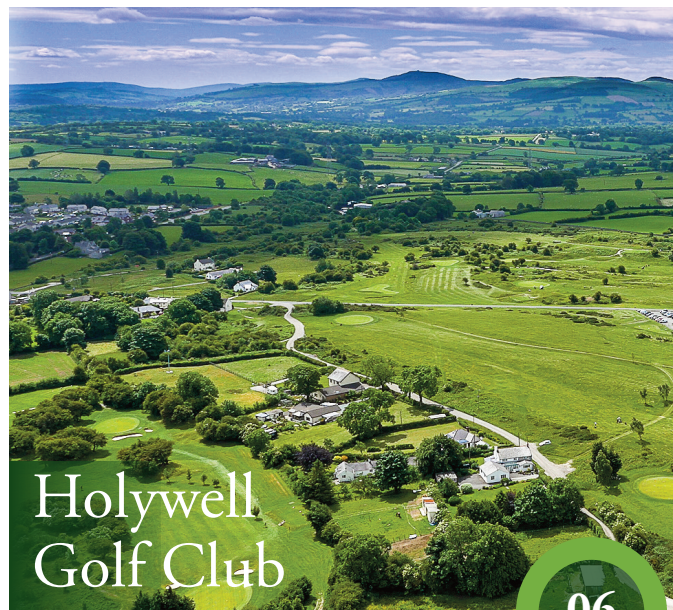
The course at Padeswood & Buckley measures 6078 yards par 70 and is bounded by the River Allyn. The river, lakes and streams mean that water can come into play on eleven of the holes. Mature trees line many of the fairways and accuracy of

the tee is a must, especially on the front nine. The flat terrain means that walking is easy, however buggies are available for hire.

Padeswood & Buckley Golf Club has a well-deserved reputation in North Wales for its welcoming and friendly atmosphere, and we look forward to you coming to see us.

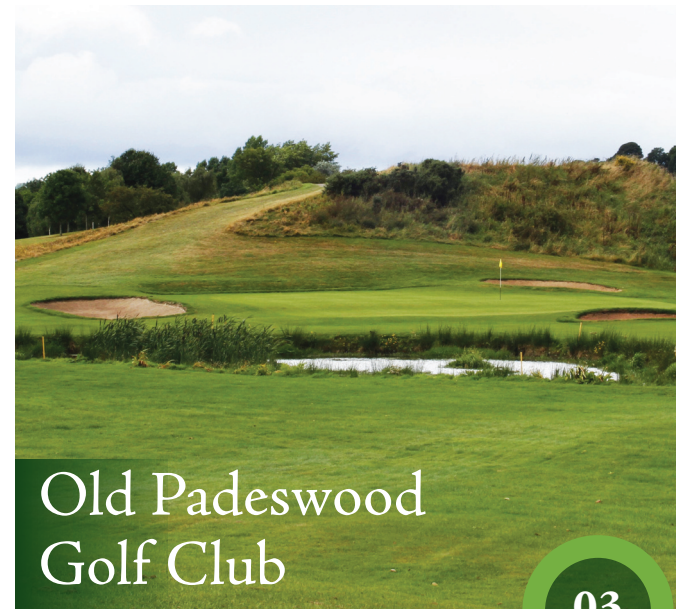

Golf was originally played at the current site of Old Padeswood Golf Club over 100 years ago.

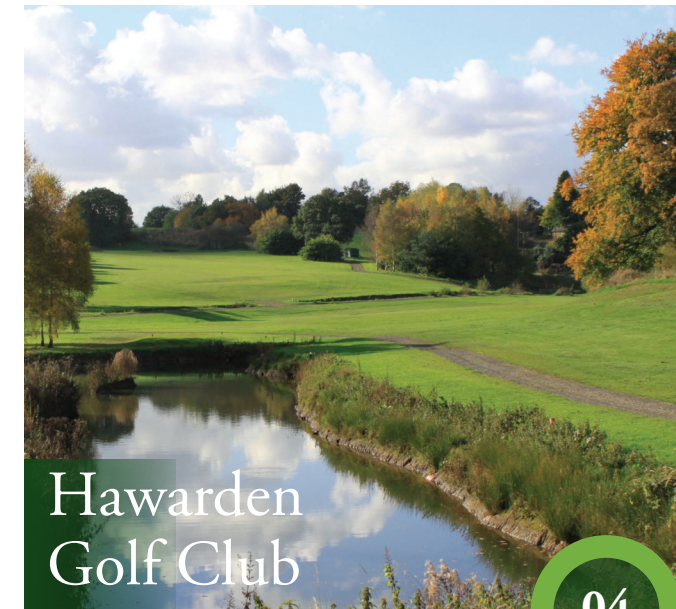
