# Explore Eryri by public Transport!





Bangor the oldest city in Wales combines fascinating history with a modern vibe – due in part to its buzzing student population. Set between Eryri Snowdonia mountains and glistening waters of the Menai Strait couldn't be more spectacular.

#### Things to do in Bangor...

Bangor Cathedral - Standing on a site that has been used for Christian worship since the 6thC, Bangor Cathedral is a feast of gothic columns and stained glass windows. Inside look out for a rare 15thC oak carving known as the Mostyn Christ and also five tiny carved mice – the signature of famous furniture maker Robert Thompson.

Penrhyn Castle and coastal footpath - With the mountains rising behind it, Penrhyn Castle is a 19thC fantasy pile built for a wealthy

industrialist who owned a vast slate quarry here. Inside you'll find ornate decoration, opulent furnishings and a fine art collection. Part of the Wales coastal path now goes through Parc Penrhyn, with views of the Menai Strait, Anglesey and Penrhyn Docks.

### Things to do in Caernarfon...

Caernarfon is home to Wales' most famous castle and an UNESCO World Heritage Site. Caernarfon Castle commands the lion's share of attention, but the town's narrow streets and stylishly redeveloped waterfront also merit a visit. The castle, built in the 13thC by Edward I as a royal palace and military fortress, was at the core of a medieval walled town.

# GELERT EXPLORER Caernarfon – Beddgelert Approx. 5 hours return

This journey will have you steaming across the footfills of Snowdon, twisting and turning on the way to Beddgelert.

## SNOWDONIA STAR Caernarfon – Porthmadog Approx. 7 hour return

This route takes you 25 miles coast to coast across the foothills of Snowdon to Porthmadog.

### THE CWELLYN Caernarofn – Rhyd Ddu Approx. 3 hour return

This trip takes form the Northern half of the Welsh Highland Railway offering scenic views over the Isle of Anglesey and onwards to the foot of Snowdon.
