


Explore the fascinating ruins of this 13th century castle and enjoy lovely views over the River Dee estuary on this interesting walk in North Wales. The castle was the first of a series of castles built during King Edward I's campaign to conquer Wales. It's a very picturesque area with the striking castle sat next to the pretty estuary. The views over the estuary to England and the Wirral are also splendid.



- Leave the station keeping left onto Y Farchnad towards Lower Sydney Street
- Turn right at Market Square, taking the stairs which crosses over the railway
- **Turn right onto Corporation Street**
- Turn left onto Castle Street
- Turn right onto Castle Dyke Street
- Turn left for 243 ft 06
- Turn right for 42 ft
- Turn left you have arrived at the Castle
